



Vocational Graduate Certificate in Leading Vocational Education (39238QLD)

Course Overview

This qualification addresses the needs of the Vocational Education and Training (VET) sector by providing practitioners with a range of high-level educational skills and knowledge that will enable them to take on complex roles and responsibilities. These roles would exist in private Registered Training Organisations, TAFE Institutes and will also extend to other organisations who engage in the in-house delivery of highly customised in-house training programs linked to the Australian Quality Training Framework.

This qualification is suitable for graduates of TAE40110 (or TAA40104) Certificate IV in Training and Assessment or the TAA50104 Diploma of Training and Assessment which are considered entry level qualifications to VET. This qualification enables VET professionals to increase the breadth, depth and complexity of their knowledge and to take on a multitude of roles and responsibilities in varied and specialised contexts. It is primarily aimed at VET professionals who are required to demonstrate professional judgement in partnership development, training and

assessment development and implementation in complex environments. This qualification is well suited to professionals who are highly accomplished, and are increasingly involved in professional partnerships and networks, organisational activities and advisory services. In addition, this qualification builds on the training and assessment skills with high-level strategic thinking and project management capabilities.

- Lead teaching and learning activities in their own organisations
- Influence product, services and practice through innovation and continuous improvement
- Develop programs, resources and services that meet the needs of clients
- Initiate and manage change processes relevant to all aspects of teaching, learning and assessment
- Work closely and develop partnerships with industry, the community and government.
